1. Submit a 60 second video(s) in one of the following formats (WebM, .AVI, .MPEG4, .MPEGS, 3GPP, .WMV, .MOV, .FLV) on a dvd or flash drive by 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 12. Videos must be smaller than 2GB and one minute or less (including any title and credits.) You can submit more than one video. Each creator should make sure their videos contain no copyright infringement. Title your video files as follows: **LastnameFirstnameVideoNumber.mov**. [ex., **SmithJohn01.mov**]
